Important Notice to Exporters

Issuance of Certificates of Origin (COO) under ISFTA, PSFTA, SAFTA and SAPTA for Areca nuts, Black Pepper, Nutmeg, Mace, Cloves, Tamarind, Cardamom and Cinnamon

With the aim of streamlining issuance of Certificates of Origin (COO) for exports of above mentioned commodities to India and Pakistan under ISFTA, PSFTA, SAFTA and SAPTA, the Department of Commerce (DOC) has decided to introduce a new COO issuance procedure with effect from 01.05.2019. Details are as follows.

Pre-shipment-Inspections

1. Export consignments of the above commodities will be subject to pre-shipment inspections, conducted by a panel consisting of officials from the DOC and Department of Export Agriculture. (DEA). In order to facilitate these inspections, exporters concerned should inform the DOC with details of their shipments at least two weeks prior to the shipment date. Exporters should use the attached format (Annex – I) for this purpose.

Air-freight Shipments

- 1. Exporters can apply for COO in advance of the shipment date.
- 2. Supporting documents to be submitted to the Department of Commerce along with COO for each airfreight shipment include:
 - Commercial Invoice
 - An affidavit (Please use the format given at Annex II for the affidavit).
- 3. After the shipment, exporters should submit the following documents to the DOC for verification purposes.
 - A copy of the Airway Bill
 - Verified Party's copy of the Export Cusdec (Original) with a photocopy
 - A copy of the Phytosanitary certificate issued by National Plant Quarantine Service

Sea-freight Shipments

- 1. COO for all sea-freight cargo will be issued only after the shipments have been made
- 2. Supporting documents to be submitted to the DOC along with COO for each sea-freight shipment include:
 - Commercial Invoice and Cargo Dispatch Note
 - An affidavit (Please use the format given at Annex II for the affidavit)
 - Verified Party's Copy of the Export Cusdec (Original) with a photocopy
 - Bill of Lading (original) with a photocopy Please note that House B/Ls and Certified True Copies will not be accepted. House B/Ls may be accepted for LCL shipments.
 - Certified application submitted to National Plant Quarantine Service(NPQS) for Phytosanitary Certificate (signed by an authorized officer of NPQS)
- 3. Exporters should enter both B/L and Container numbers in Box no. 6 of the COO

N.B.

- 1. Exporters should include in the COO the declaration, which is shown in the specimen (Annex III)
- 2. For both air-freight and sea-freight shipment, exporters should indicate in cage 36 of the CUSDEC the abbreviation of the applicable trade agreement (eg. ISFTA / PSFTA / SAPTA)
- 3. The DOC will be compelled to refuse issuance COO in the event of non-compliance with the above requirements.
- 4. In the case of air-freight shipments, the DOC may cancel the issued COO if the documents to be provided after the shipment are not submitted to the DOC within 10 calendar days from the date of shipment.
- 5. The DOC has the right to cancel any COO, if post-shipment verifications reveal that the exporting company, any of its representatives, agents or person nominated by it have made any false declarations, submitted false or fraudulent documents / statements or by word or deed misrepresented any facts relating to origin or any other relevant matter.

Note 2: How Obtained or Produced
